This fund update was first made publicly available on 28 June 2017.

What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the MISS Scheme (Scheme) has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the Scheme with other funds. The trustees of the MISS Scheme prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

The Scheme targets a 40% allocation to growth assets (equities, listed and unlisted property, commodities and listed and unlisted infrastructure) and a 60% allocation to income assets (fixed interest and cash and cash equivalents). The investment objective is to earn a return, after tax and investment expenses, that exceeds inflation by 2.5% per annum over the longer term (10 years).

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Scheme



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the Scheme's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.


Example of how this applies to an investor

Mary had \$10,000 in the Scheme at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Mary received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$580.00 (that is 5.80% of her initial \$10,000). Mary also paid \$369.76 in other charges. This gives Mary a total return after tax of \$210.24 for the year.³
